SUNDAY REFLECTION

Vocation Sunday – April 21st, 2024

It's up to all of us to encourage those who take their Baptism and Confirmation seriously to consider the call to commit themselves to the service of evangelization full-time, through the gift of themselves to Christ and his Church. We must nurture the living hope that a renewal of vocations to the priestly ministry is possible, because the mission of proclaiming the Gospel today demands it, to give the People of God, the servants of the Word that we need in order to pursue our mission.
