THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD – JUNE 2, 2019

WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you and you will be my witnesses . . . to the ends of the earth." Acts 1: 9

Jesus has gathered His disciples near Bethany. It is Ascension Thursday, forty days after Easter. Before He ascends into Heaven, He reminds them to be His witnesses – to go out to the whole world to proclaim His love. But first, they must return to Jerusalem and pray for the Holy Spirit to empower them. Thus they begin the first Novena—nine days of prayer.

1. The whole creation awaits fulfillment. "We are all aware that the whole creation...has been groaning in labor pains. . .We too who have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we are groaning inside ourselves, waiting with eagerness for our bodies to be set free." (Romans 8:26.) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
2. Christ promised to send the Paraclete. "I shall ask the Father, and He will give you another Paraclete to be with you forever. Peace I give you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." (John 14: 15-26) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
3. The Spirit is Soul of Christ's Body, the Church. "We were baptized into one body in a single spirit." (1 Cor. 12) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
4. Here is the Dignity of the Christian. "Do you not realize that you are the temple of God with the Spirit of God living in you?" (1 Cor. 3) **COME HOLY SPIRIT!**
5. We are gifted to serve. "There are many different gifts, but it is always the same Spirit...There remain, faith, hope, and love...and the greatest of these is love." (1 Cor. 12: 13) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
6. We are human, weak and sinful. "The Spirit too comes to help us in our weakness. . .the prayers that the Spirit makes for God's holy people are always in accordance with the mind of God." (Romans 8: 27) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
7. We grow in the freedom that love gives. "Since we are living by the Spirit, let our behavior be guided by the Spirit and let us not be conceited or provocative or envious of one another." (Galatians 5:26) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
8. The Spirit's Love gifts us with knowledge, understanding, and wisdom. "God has given revelation through the Spirit, for the Spirit explores the depths of everything, even the depths of God." (1 Cor. 2:9) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**
9. We are sent with the power to reconcile. "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive anyone's sins, they are forgiven." (John 20:23) **COME, HOLY SPIRIT!**

Spirit of wisdom, Spirit of understanding, Spirit of adoration.

Come, Spirit of the Lord!

Spirit of strength, Spirit of knowledge. Spirit of joy.

Come, Spirit of the Lord!

Saint Padre Pio is a beloved Italian Capuchin Catholic priest who was canonized by John Paul II in 2002. During his lifetime, he became known for bearing the stigmata (wounds of Christ).
