Something to think about ...

Isaiah 43:18-19a. Do not remember the former things, or consider the things of old, I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? The poetry of the book of Isaiah is riveting, and the message is challenging and comforting on this Fifth Sunday in Lent. We have walked the Lenten journey for five weeks, and time is drawing nigh for the holiest of all weeks in our Christian calendar. What former things do we need to leave behind? And what new things must we consider? What will spring forth? Are we ready to make the final walk with Jesus into Jerusalem?

With stories like those we are reading in the Gospel of John - Jesus raising Lazarus and admonishing Judas – it is clear that Jesus is teaching the disciples not to "consider the things of old." The "new thing" that is springing forth is the letting go of the old way of doing things like hoarding money and clinging to life. Jesus has come to set us free, so free that even in death, we will have life.
