REFLECTION

Luke 23:47b. Certainly this man was innocent.

In the moment just after Jesus takes his last breath on the cross, the Gospel of Luke gives us a bold statement of Jesus' innocence, a truth ignored except by Pilate, who claims Jesus' innocence, the centurion, and the criminal hanging beside Jesus who cries out, "This man has done nothing wrong."

When we read the passion narrative today and cry out the words of the crowd, "Crucify him, crucify him!," we, too, ignore his innocence and silence his voice. We are reminded how often we are complicit in hurting others and condemning the innocent. Christ calls us to follow the truth and be a witness for righteousness.
