And so we arrive at Christmas – the most wonderful time of the year. But Christmas isn't a mere celebration of an overnight occurrence or the commemoration of a sudden intervention. No, the arrival of the Messiah Jesus was an eternity in the making. Jesus came to us and for us "when the set time had finally come".

What an extraordinary thing to consider! The timeless One, who for all eternity existed but entered the world to bring eternity to us!
