REFLECTION

As we mark the final Sunday before Holy Week begins, we hear a story that will be told at the great Vigil of Easter: Ezekiel's Valley of the Dry Bones. We stand with Jesus as he weeps and cries, "Lazarus, come out!" and his dead friend lives again. The Bible whispers to us about what is coming at Easter; new life is always possible.

In my own life, there have been moments that have felt more like dry bones. There are moments when, like Jesus, I have felt loss and wept. Faith doesn't shield us from loss. Religion can't take away sorrow. There are moments in my prayer life when the only word I can muster toward God is "Why?"

What I have learned is that these moments are only moments. Our story is not over until God has reached into all the graves we dig for ourselves to lift us out. It doesn't take away sorrow, but it does help our hearts to hold on for the next line in the story.
