REFLECTIONS ON

THE WAY OF THE CROSS

Let's continue our journey with Jesus:

“Station 4” Jesus Meets His Mother

Was it your mother, Jesus, who first taught you to pray? I hear an echo of “your will be done” in her own words of assent: “Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord”. Today, her heart is pierced again by what must seem an impossible request – to go on loving those who persecute you. Help me to model Mary's spirit, dear Lord. Teach me to find you, even when I am deeply troubled by the circumstances of life.

“Station 5” Simon Helps Jesus Carry the Cross

I know how I would have felt if I'd been in Simon's sandals at this moment: “Why me?” Why couldn't the soldiers have picked on someone else to share in your pain? Perhaps that's how Simon reacted initially too, but he went forward anyway, and in so doing, he experienced the profound grace of a close encounter with You. I ask you, Lord, to bless my reluctance, just as you did for Simon. Help me to see impositions as opportunities for oneness with you.
